- **5-minute presentation** of your research
  - **5-minute audience and panel discussion**

#### Submission Guidelines

- **Format:** Structured abstract (Background, Methods, Results, Conclusion)
  - **Word limit:** Maximum **250 words**
  - **Title:** Concise and informative
  - **Authors & Affiliations:** List all contributors and institutions
  - **Language:** English
  - **File type:** MS Word or PDF
- 

#### Eligibility

- Open to researchers, clinicians, and trainees holding a current position at an academic institution and/or NHS Trust in the UK.
- Work must be **original** and current (unpublished).

## Review Criteria

Abstracts will be evaluated based on:

- **Scientific merit**
- **Innovation and relevance**
- **Clarity of presentation**

- **Notification of acceptance:** 17<sup>th</sup> February 2026
